For all "sharp" keys, you can determine the key of the piece given the key signature as follows:
 Look at the **last sharp** in the key signature. Which note of the staff is it on?
 (Remember FACE or Every Good Boy Does Fine) Go up one note and that is the key of the piece.

For example, the third measure above has 2 sharps in the key signature, the second sharp being C.
 One step up from C is D. So that measure is in the key of D.
